## Conversion Facts On Migrating Data Into PayClock Version 6

Moving to Version 6 is not necessarily an "upgrade" to the current software. Version 6 is a completely different design that uses a Sybase SQL Anywhere database whereas Versions 5 and earlier uses a File System Database Structure. Some functionality could be lost, depending on what features are used in the old version of PayClock. The features that are not available in PayClock Version 6 include:

- •Consecutive Day Overtime
- •Custom Rounding Rules
- Ability To Add Time Back For Breaks
- •Premium Time Zones
- •Preset Holiday Calendars
- Track Worked Holidays
- Accrual Policies and Accrual Rules
- •Shift Differential Adjustments
- •Custom Pay Codes
- Pay Code Adjusters
- •Restricting Access To Specific Employees
- •Customizable Reports

When moving to Version 6, Data Migration converts the following data into the new database:

- •Company Information The company name and address will be migrated.
- •Employees Active as well as Inactive and Terminated employees can be migrated.
- •Payroll Rules The pay period and overtime rules will be migrated.
- •Departments Departments will be migrated.
- •Punch Data The two open pay periods will be migrated. This include Tips.
